Registration form for Beginner Beekeeping Course

Hosted by Norfolk County Beekeepers Association

Our course is designed for people who wish to gain an understanding of bee biology and beekeeping practices in order to begin the fascinating art of beekeeping. Those who are just curious or are as yet unsure about beginning this endeavor are also encouraged to enroll. Classes will consist of eight to ten weekly meetings (depending on progress made). The classes are held on Wednesday night, beginning at 7:00 pm and ending around 9 or 9:30. Bee School runs from late January until the beginning of April. Dates are: Wednesday, February 3; Tuesday, February 9; Wednesday, February 24, March 3; Tuesday, March 9; Wednesday, March 17, 24, 31; Wednesday, April 7, and Tuesday April 13. Classes will be held at the Norfolk County Agricultural School cafeteria in Walpole with some classes as lectures and others hands-on style with participation in assembling beekeeping equipment. In addition to the above, there will be one field demonstration in April on Installing a package of bees into a new hive.

Tuition is \$50.00 per person (including families). The tuition includes beekeeping equipment supply catalogues, and related hand outs. There will be no course book, but we will provide you with a list of recommended reading materials.
