
New Colonies

 Nutritional needs are in the hands of the keeper and gradually handing off to Mother Nature

 Goal is To establish the colony, it's hive and position it for winter survival


 Packages: It takes until about the middle of June for there to be enough bees to build out the first brood chamber.

 Nucs are much faster requiring a second brood chamber by late May/early June




- When to expand?
 - Add a second story when the cluster has expanded to 8 of 10 frames and frames 9/10 are starting to build out (numbered from 1 edge to other)

 Continue feeding syrup & protein



Brood cluster

- Chimney Effect
 - Occurs when you expand too soon and the bees ignore the outside frames
- Remember that queen behavior is to move upwards!



Brood cluster

- When to stop feeding?
- Feed until they swarm!
- Stop when there is only 3 or 4 frames of foundation left or no longer feeding on syrup
